New Trait-Enhanced Soybean Meal Varieties

QUALISOY is currently collaborating with the industry to develop two trait-enhanced meal varieties – Enhanced Nutritional Energy Soybeans (ENE) and Reduced Carbohydrate Soybeans (RCS) – which will provide improved nutritional benefits for swine and poultry.


Trait-enhanced soybean meal varieties, ENE and RCS, are expected to be commercialized by 2023 and 2030, respectively.


ENE soybeans provide increased levels of nutritional energy and essential amino acids by converting non-nutritional carbohydrates into nutrients, and are expected to be commercialized by 2023.

RCS will feature less non-nutritional carbohydrates, while maintaining protein levels and increasing oil content. The goal is to create a soybean that will be more valuable, compared to a conventional soybean, due to the fact that oil is worth more than meal per pound, and the associated meal will be more beneficial. RCS are expected to be commercialized by 2030.
